

MODERATE SEDATION EDUCATION PROGRAM

Privileging Criteria:

A provider requesting initial Moderate Sedation Privileges will:

1. Be board certified or eligible (or equivalent training) in one of the following:
 - a. Internal Medicine and subspecialties
 - b. Surgery and Surgical specialties
 - c. Orthopedics
 - d. Pediatrics
 - e. Anesthesia
 - f. Medical Imaging

2. Submit the following required documentation:
 - a. Current American Heart Association (AHA) ACLS certification for persons 18 years of age and older, PALS certification for persons younger than 18 years of age and not a neonate, and NRP certification for neonatologists only.
 - b. Crouse/SUNY/SJH moderate sedation education program certificate of completion or documentation of passing test score of at least 80%. (Neonatologists are excluded.)
 - c. Attestation of DVD review. (Neonatologists are excluded)
 - d. Ten Case logs noting prior experience during residency or fellowship -or-
 - e. Log of 5 cases proctored by current medical staff member with moderate sedation privileges -or-
 - f. Letter from SUNY/SJH documenting current moderate sedation privileges.
